Sangha Lunch Offering/ Dana

To reflect traditional Vesak celebrations in many Buddhist communities we are providing a lunch offering to the Sangha collectively. This will be done in the Parish Hall of St. Peters Church Eastern Hill (15 Gisborne Street East Melbourne VIC 3002) prior to our Vesak Procession. We will also be providing an opportunity to do an offering in the form which was customary in the Buddha's time which is an Alms Round. (Pindabata in the Pali language). The public are invited to offer cooked rice (provided at the venue) during the Alms round whilst main meals will be served in the dining hall.

- Sangha and participants are to meet at 9.30am at the St Peter Eastern Hill main door at 15 Gisborne Street, East Melbourne
- The drop off parking spaces for buses is on Gisborne Street
- The Pindabata to be held along Gisborne Street will commence at 10.00am (Participation in the Alms round is optional)
- The main lunch offering will be held at St Peter Eastern Hill main hall and this will start 11.00am (all meals will be vegetarian).
